Notes:

* Rachel McQuillan has played the main draw more often (eight times) than any other Australian woman during the above period. Nicole Bradtke played the main draw seven times.

* only three Australian women have reached the quarter finals or better since 1990, Nicole Bradtke in 1991, 1995 and 1996, Alicia Molik won in 2005 and Samantha Stosur was in the final in 2005.

* Rachel McQuillan, Nicole Bradtke and Alicia Molik are the only Australian women with a wild card to advance past the first round - McQuillan, 1997, Bradtke, 1995, Molik, 1998. Dokic played as an Australian in 2000 when she reached the second round as a wild card.

* the last Australian women to be seeded were Hana Mandlikova (4), Ann Minter (15) in 1990 and Alicia Molik (6) 2005.
